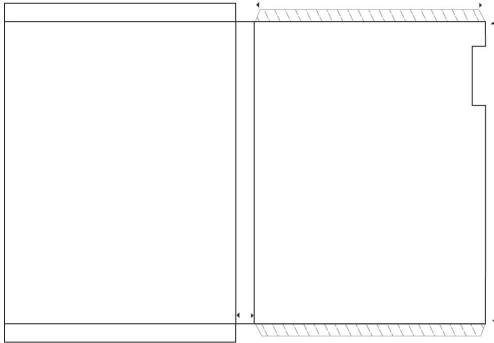

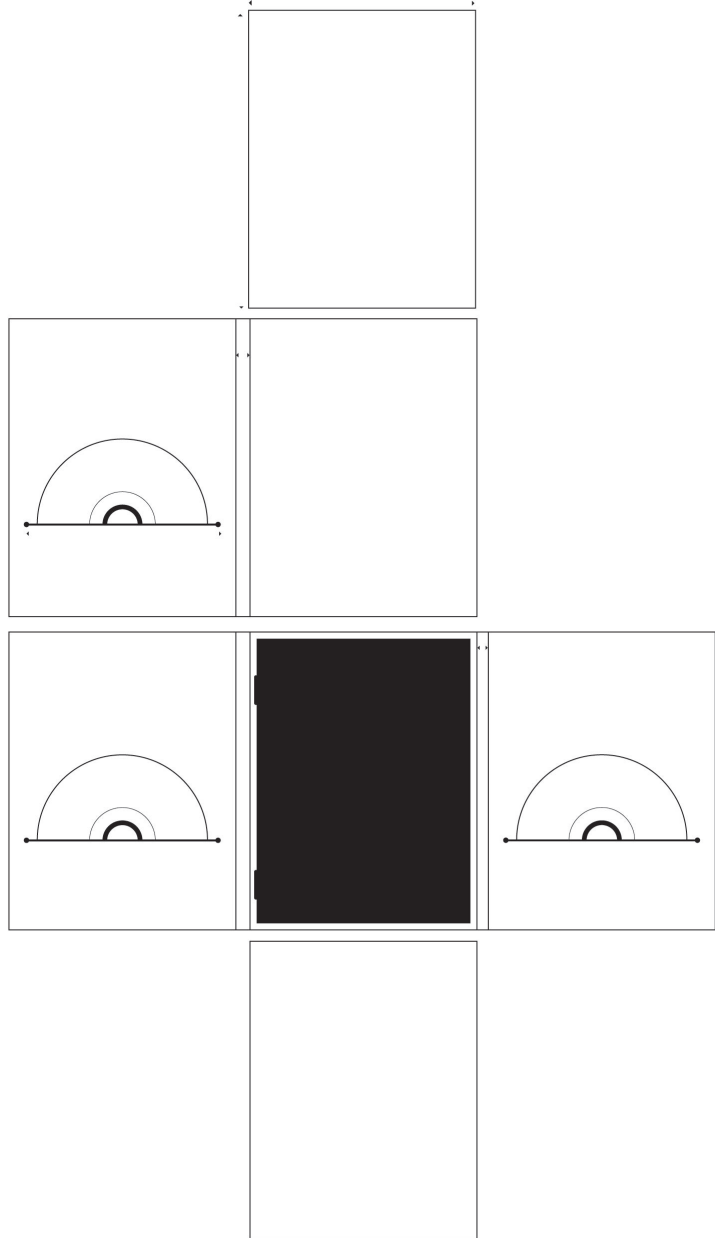

1 What is Powerchair Football ?

Powerchair Football is a dynamic and fast sport whose sporting rules are inspired primarily by football. Equipped with a system fixed on the frame of the powerchair called "bumper", the players push and strike the ball in full safety.

This sport knows one big hit and of many countries mobilize themselves to set up the structures necessary to its development.

2 The International Federation of Powerchair Football Association

Practiced in various forms since the middle of the Eighties, six countries linked their efforts to harmonize the sporting rules and to lead to creation in 2006 of the International federation of Powerchair Football. From now on universal, this sport develops throughout the world on the various continents.

The FIPFA is an international association made up of National organizations of Powerchair Football, (NOPF). To subscribe to the federation, the NOPF pay an annual affiliation and take part every two years in the general meeting during whom are elected part of the members of the committee management.

In order to coordinate the competitions and to facilitate the development of Powerchair football, the FIPFA lays out of geographical areas called "Areas". These areas are parts integral of the Federation and are under the responsibility of an elected president.
